Internet: if you would like to get online some hotels and other locations will have wifi hotspots. In order to use those hotspots, you will need to purchase 1-hour internet cards. These will be available for purchase at some hotels, usually.

Telephone: Many hotels will offer the service of international calls. You will have to pay for this service. Rates will vary.
